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FISHING REPORT

Summer is reminding us just how hot and steamy it can get. This sultry weather has certainly been favourable for the hard-core mangrove jack and pelagic fisho's. Lets have a look at the report -

Tin Can Bay is reporting good quality summer whiting and flathead with the odd spottie mackerel and golden trevally taken in the channel.

Kauri Creek, Butha creek, Poona, Boonoroo and Maaroom are all reporting mangrove jack, estuary cod, summer whiting and flathead, with a mixed bag of quality reef fish coming from Kinbackers ledge, Deep Creek and the Moonboom coffee rock ledges.

Threadfin Salmon and bull sharks are still on the move in the sandy straits chasing small bait fish in the shallows, and golden trevally, queen fish and schoolie mackerel taking trolling lures in the deeper channels between the bluff and moon point.

The Mary River is fishing well again with reports of threadfin salmon up to 11 kilo's and good quality grunter between beaver rock and river heads. Still plenty of Bull sharks around for our avid shark fans.

Heaps of pelagic action in Platypus Bay right up to Wathumba , just have to beat the sharks.

The artificial reef continues to keep anglers happy with black spot tusk fish, Blackall, and the odd coral trout.

Burrum Heads has been reporting good quality catches of whiting, bream and flathead, with the odd mangrove and jack and threadfin salmon.

Our mud crabs are still running with reports coming from Beaver Rock to Kauri Creek.

Lenthals is firing up with lots of barra giving our anglers an adrenaline rush and Tinana creek although running hard is fishing well for bass.

Brag board –

First up is Charlie with a cracker of a barra.

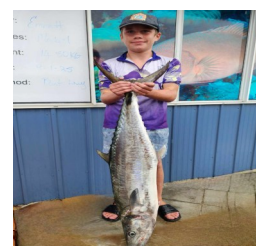


Forrest landed this 11.4kg

“Hot Flashes”

Sandy Straits RFB Volunteers Standing Proud

Hello from the Sandy Straits Rural Fire Brigade,

your very own Brigade supporting our

wonderful community. Already we have had

call outs to people who are burning stacks

without permits or the stack is oversized.



BURNING STACKS: You may burn your own small stack if it is safe to do so. There is no wind, you have a prepared bare earth fire break around it, it is under 2mts square in any direction and you have water and fire fighting equipment near the stack.

BE COURTEOUS to your neighbors. Let them know when you intend to burn. Make sure that the stack is not left unattended. There is nothing worse than having completed a load of washing to have it smoked from a fire close by. A fire may seem to be out but a wind change may spark it up again. All care needs to be taken. It is your responsibility to put the fire out completely.

PERMITS FROM THE FIRE WARDEN. RING THE Fire Warden on 07 5488 2112, to obtain a permit. If you have a stack 2mts in any direction, you will require a Permit- which will set out the requirements of your burn. Read the permit carefully and obey all the requirements. You must ring the Sandy Straits Rural Fire Brigade before lighting up and the Number on the permit for the RFD, that will be on your permit. Please note large tree trunks have volume and mass. They take a long time to burn and will require a permit. The Fire Warden is a voluntary role and he will provide you with the following help: granting or rejecting applications for permit to light fire, determining the conditions under which permitted fires can be lit, advising owners and occupiers of the need for fuel and hazard reduction, recommending safety precautions for the protection of homes and assets.
